Paid Entry Fee Refund Policy:

Any entry fee refunded before Thursday, November 3rd, 2011 will be subject to a \$50.00 administration fee. A credit card payment transaction processing fee will not be refunded if applicable. Once registration closes on day of event no eligible refunds

Withdrawal from Event:

Notification of withdrawal must be made to the Competitor Registrar by fax, in writing or by calling as soon as you know you cannot compete by Friday, November 4th, 2011.

Exceptions to Rally America Rules:

1. Transits less than 1 mile shall have transit times of less than 7 minutes (RA Article 5.5)
2. Stage notes will be prepared by Mike and Paula Gibeault (RA Article 6.6)
3. Scores will be declared final on Monday, November 7th @ 12:00 PM (RA Article 17.3)

Stage Notes And One-Pass Recce:

This Year's event features Stage Notes prepared by Mike and Paula Gibeault and Crew. There will be a Notes Familiarization Pass (Recce) on Saturday morning.

Per Rally America street legal vehicles EXCLUDING rally vehicles must be used. The notes expense is being absorbed by the organizers and no refunds will be given if your team chooses not to use them. If you intend to use Notes you are REQUIRED to run the Recce, or forfeit the opportunity to use the Notes.

Stage and Road Conditions:

This year's event will be comprised of seven special stages for a total of 40.7 miles.

Total Course 118.5 miles.

Type of Road Surfaces: Bladed County maintained gravel roads, some rocky areas, sandy washes and corners with exposures.

Stage Signage- Caution signs will be labeled as follows; Single Caution "!!"; Double Caution "!!!"; Triple Caution "!!!!".

Advisory directional arrows where appropriate; contrasting arrow colors will be used on stages run in the opposite direction.

Service Area:

Service will be located in the reserved parking area of the Gold Strike parking lot.

Speed limit inside service is 5 mph and offending teams will be penalized 10 minutes.

Please leave the Service Area as clean as or cleaner than when you arrived.

Tarps MUST be used under vehicles during service, or the offending crews and vehicles will be penalized 10 minutes.

No welding is allowed

Refueling Depot Area:

Refueling is allowed only in the designated area near service. You must fuel on the tarps that will be provided.

Service Crew Registration:

All service crew members must sign the event Waiver and Release Form.

Minor release forms must be signed by a parent or guardian for anyone under 16.

Proof of basic liability insurance for servicing vehicles must be shown at registration.

Fuel:

Service Stations are located on either side of I-15 in Jean (Shell and Mobil) and are conveniently located near the hotel. There is no gas in the town of Goodsprings. If you require race fuel please bring your own as none is available for Seed 9.

Spectator Areas:

There will be no spectator area for viewing except for credentialed media.

Competition Classes:

All eligible vehicles will be recognized according to Rally America and California Rally Series classes. Bilstein USA Southwest RallyCup Series adheres to the Rally America classes.

Scoring /Awards/Cash Prizes:

Rally America/ Bilstein USA Southwest RallyCup, and California Rally Series provisional scores will be posted after the last car finishes the rally at the post rally party on the official notice board. Scores will become final at 12:00 PM on Monday November 7th, 2010.

Event awards will be provided for First Place for each of the Rally America and California Rally Series classes. Event awards deeper in class may be offered if entries dictate.

Bilstein USA Southwest RallyCup Series will provide cash prizes (totaling at least \$300.00) to 1st and 2nd place teams in each RA class that finishes the event. The SWRC will have Lucas Oil product to give out to top teams in the Lucas Oil 2WD.
